Our History

Rock County Christian School opened its doors to K-6 students in the fall of 1985. One grade per year was added until the school grew to K-9 for the 1988-1989 school year. For this period of time classes were conducted in the school building located on Happy Hollow Road between Janesville and Beloit. In 1990 the school expanded to K-12. This expansion was accomplished through the purchase of a second building in Beloit, Wisconsin.

The school has continued to grow, through God's grace, and we currently serve over 200 students from over 100 families, which represent over 40 different churches. Grades pre-K (including infant care) through 5 attend classes at our Primary Education Campus, located at the original Janesville location, while grades 6 through 12 attend classes at the Secondary Education Campus, located in Beloit.
